What is a Rule 1.2 Representative?

<p>Your Rule 1.2 Representative will be allocated to you by the Court of Protection following the Judge's decision to restrict your movements for your own safety.</p>	
<p>Your Rule 1.2 Representative will visit you regularly to listen to what you have to say about your placement and will also speak to your care staff.</p>	
<p>They will check that all the conditions have been met to ensure you are being looked after and supported with respect to your needs.</p>	
<p>They will look at your Care Plan with your permission.</p>	

They will make sure that you are safe.



They will contact your Social Worker or the Court of Protection to make sure your situation is reviewed. Actions will be taken to improve your placement.



They will make sure others know if you are asking to leave your placement or if the conditions placed by the courts are not being supported appropriately.



They will ensure that your rights are upheld by contacting a solicitor who will take your case forward to the Court of Protection
