To file a dispute with Expedia, contact their customer service by phone, ₩ 1 (855) (7 16) (3282) (uk) or + 44 (808) (175) (7375) (us) ₩ chat, or through the "Help" or "Contact Us" section on their website or app, providing your booking details and a detailed explanation of the issue. If your dispute is not resolved, you can escalate it to a supervisor, ₩ +1 (855) (716) (3282) (uk) or + 44 (808) (175) (7375) (us) ₩ with the Better Business Bureau (BBB), or initiate a chargeback with your credit card company.

Step 1: Contact Expedia customer service

- Phone: Call a customer service number like ₩ 并 1 (855) (716) (3282) (uk) or + 44 (8 08) (175) (7375) (us) ₩ w for assistance. Some sources suggest other numbers like ₩ +1 (855) (716) (3282) (uk) or + 44 (808) (175) (7375) (us) ₩ w for different issues.
- Online: Use the "Help" or "Contact Us" section in your Expedia account on the website or mobile app.
- Chat or Email: Some numbers can connect you to chat support.

Step 2: Provide necessary information

- Have your booking confirmation number ready.
- Clearly explain the issue and why you believe the charge is incorrect.
- Provide any supporting documentation you have.

Step 3: If your issue is unresolved

- **Escalate:** Ask to speak to a supervisor or manager.

- Contact the BBB: File a complaint with the Better Business Bureau.

• Contact your bank: Initiate a chargeback with your credit card company. It is important to attempt to resolve the issue with Expedia first to strengthen your chargeback case.
